An update from Glebe Farm School Project

Welcome to Morgan Sindall's Glebe Farm School Project.



## Project Overview

Glebe farm school is an all through school that Morgan Sindall's Northern Home Counties office has been selected to deliver by Milton Keynes Council. We commenced construction on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2021 and are due to hand the completed school over in September 2022.

The schools structure consists of steel frame and precast planks to the upper floors. Externally, a mixture of cladding, curtain walling and brickwork has been designed to provide a modern look for the school. There will also be a sports hall, multi use games areas, as well as a number of Sport England pitches, providing vast sporting facilities for the students and local community.

## Project Update

Over the month of May, the foundations for the building have continued to progress well and are nearly complete. The erection of the steel frame for the main building structure began during this time and has continued at a great pace, despite the difficult weather conditions we have faced during this particularly wet May! The large steel frame will continue for the next few months.

The Perimeter fencing works has continued and is due for completion within the next week. Our site office and welfare installation is now complete, offering excellent facilities to the local workforce on site, with picnic benches to enjoy break time outdoors, and some sports facilities for some healthy competition amongst trades

## What's happening this month

This month we will continue to erect the steel frame and install the pre-cast concrete planks which create the floors for the first and second levels. We will also begin pouring the ground floor concrete slab and commence works on the sports pitches.


The construction of the substation which will provide electricity to the building is due to commence at the beginning of June and will be complete the following month.

As part of our site office and welfare set up, we have installed solar panels to our cabins to reduce our usage of mains power electricity.

We also have a wheel wash which recycles all the water used, whilst keeping the roads and vehicles leaving site clean

Our site hoarding is made from 100% recycled material, carbon neutral and will be either re-used on another project or recycled once again. As part of our carbon pledge, we are also planting 38 trees to reduce our carbon footprint.
